- The deadline for abstract submission for INVITED SPEAKERS and POSTER PRESENTERS is January 31, 2014.
- The abstract needs to be submitted to the e-mail address (jkism2014@med.kurume-u.ac.jp) from December 1, 2013 to January 31, 2014.

ABSTRACT PREPARATION

- Abstracts should be written in English on an A4-sized page.
- The text should be single-spaced using Times New Roman font of 14 point for title, 12 point for authors name, affiliation and text. Title and authors should be in bold letters.
- Figures and Tables can be included in the text.
- Abstracts should be a single page for POSTER PRESENTATION and less than 4 pages for INVITED SPEAKERS.

PRESENTATION

ORAL PRESENTATION

- Please bring your computer and battery cable. The computer should be equipped with D-submini 15 pins, or adaptor, which can connect to an LCD projector.
- Please check your presentation data at PC Preview Desk at least 20 minutes before your presentation.
- Oral session room will be equipped with an LCD projector, a screen, microphones, and a laser pointer. Sound output equipment will not be available.
- If your presentation requires some other equipment, you must contact the symposium secretary (jkism2014@med.kurume-u.ac.jp) prior to the symposium, and you will be responsible for any charges incurred.
- Presenters are also requested to bring the presentation data by CD-R or USB-flash memory for the back-up of your presentation date.
- The duration of oral presentations except for the Special Lecture will be 15 minutes with a further 5 minutes for discussion.


POSTER PRESENTATION

- Presenters of posters are requested to be in front of their posters during the session for discussions.
